

Chatham County Line's tenth studio release, 'Hiyo,' marks a fresh start for the North Carolina roots band. Recorded at Asheville's Echo Mountain studio with co-producer/engineer Rachael Moore, the album sees the band embracing change, experimenting with new sounds, and adding synthesizers, drum machines, and more electric guitar and percussion to their traditional instrumentation. This evolution injects their classic songwriting with new vitality.

Established over twenty years ago in Raleigh, North Carolina, Chatham County Line has built a devoted following with their genre-blending live shows and a string of critically acclaimed albums. While 'Hiyo' signifies a new chapter for the band, it's worth noting that 2020's 'Strange Fascination' was their last album with banjo player Chandler Holt.

TOWN MOUNTAIN

Hailing from Asheville, North Carolina, Town Mountain is the sum of all its vast and intricate influences — this bastion of alt-country rebellion and honky-tonk attitude pushed through the hardscrabble Southern Appalachian lens of its origin.

Amid a renewed sense of self is the group's latest album, "Lines in the Levee," a collage of sound and scope running the gamut of the musical spectrum in the same template of freedom and focus found in the round-robin fashion of the musical institution that is The Band — a solidarity also found in the incendiary live shows Town Mountain is now revered for from coast-to-coast, this devil-may-care gang of strings and swagger.



FIRESIDE COLLECTIVE

A quartet who cheerfully disregard every kind of one-dimensional label that might be attached to their music, Fireside Collective has been on a roll since emerging seven years ago from the fertile roots music scene of Asheville, North Carolina. In quick order, the progressive bluegrass group released its debut album, won the 2016 Band Contest at MerleFest, earned an International Bluegrass Music Association Momentum Band of the Year nomination and embarked on an ambitious touring schedule that's earned an enthusiastic reception from traditional bluegrass to wide-ranging, eclectic music festival audiences alike.

Blending the characteristic interplay of bluegrass instrumentation and harmonies with strong original material and exuberant energy, Fireside Collective has drawn on folk, blues, funk and a wide variety of bluegrass sounds to create a distinctive body of work that's all their own.

BLUE HIGHWAY

In 2023, the highly-esteemed bluegrass band Blue Highway celebrates 29 years of touring, with four of the original members still intact. Its single "On the Roof of the World" was number one on the Bluegrass Today National Airplay chart for 4 weeks from July to August 2022, and was the number one song for the month of September while its follow-up "Lonesome State of Mind" was number one five times on the weekly chart and for the months of February, March and May 2023.

The band has earned a collective 33 IBMA Awards, 6 SPBGMA Awards, one Dove Award, plus three Grammy nominations. Most recently, the band was nominated for IBMA's 2022, 2021 and 2020 Vocal Group of the Year and Song of the Year Awards.





OUR MISSION

We are an arts organization whose mission is to enrich, inspire, and educate through live performances of high-quality music.

WHO ARE WE?

Recognized as a pillar of creativity, inspiration, and entertainment, the Spartanburg Philharmonic is a modern orchestra with roots in the 1895 May Festival, the precursor of the South Atlantic States Music Festival founded in 1898, one of only four such festivals featuring orchestras in the United States at that time. Almost a century old, Spartanburg Philharmonic is a jewel in the crown of South Carolina's arts scene, presenting popular masterworks, contemporary pieces, chamber music, bluegrass, and rarely performed works. Concerts attract music lovers throughout the Greater Spartanburg area and from around the region.

A 65-member professional orchestra, the Philharmonic's original name at its founding in 1928 was the Spartanburg Symphony Orchestra. The organization has gone through several incarnations since, and took on its current name, Spartanburg Philharmonic, in 2018. Spartanburg Philharmonic offers three music series: Zimmerli (full symphony concerts), Espresso (chamber music), and Bluegrass. Performances are held in Spartanburg's historic 1489-seat Twichell Auditorium in Zimmerli Performance Center at Converse University, and at the Chapman Cultural Center's 476-seat Theater, the premier arts venue in the Greater Spartanburg area.


